



Archibald "Archie" Marcotte

Archibald "Archie" Marcotte of Pembroke Pines, FL, formerly of Loganville, GA passed away in Miami, FL on March 22, after a period of declining health and hospitalization. He was born at Camp Kilmer in New Jersey, August 27, 1948, the son of Gerald and Ann Marcotte, both deceased. He leaves behind his wife Kathy Schurawich Parker Marcotte of Pembroke Pines, FL, his two children Nicholas and Melissa, and two grandchildren, all of the Loganville Georgia area. After his return, he attended and graduated from Georgia State University in 1977 with a BA in Business Administration. He spent most of his career working in the optical field for Robertson Optical as a regional salesman. He enjoyed lasting relationships with his co-workers and customers, treating them like family. At the time of his death, he was still consulting for Robertson on a part-time basis, despite having retired to Florida for the past 2 and a half years. Archie was a true gentleman and had the gift of a great sense humor. He enjoyed listening to comedy on the radio. He loved writing computer code and liked to keep up with technology. He was the computer answer man for his friends. He was very dedicated to whatever endeavors he took on, both professionally and personally. In his spare time, he enjoyed traveling within the U.S. including to Connecticut, Las Vegas, Cherokee, N.C. and Biloxi, Mississippi, where he enjoyed playing penny slot machines. Archie became a cat lover later in life, thanks to his wife Kathy's influence. He was particularly attached to their recently adopted tuxedo cat, Cookie.
