Couch – Roy Garner Couch, age 85, of Snellville, passed away peacefully at home on Thursday, November 16, 2017 after a long battle with cancer. Funeral services will be held at 3:00 PM on Monday, November 20, 2017 in the Snellville Chapel of Tim Stewart Funeral Home with Rev. Walter Jones and Dr. Jim Cantrell officiating. A private interment will be held at a later date. Mr. Couch was born on February 4, 1932. He grew up in Grayson in a large family and spent his entire life in Gwinnett County. After graduating from Grayson High School he served his country in the Army for two years during the Korean Conflict. He continued to support both Grayson High School and Couch Middle School as a spirited volunteer. He was a member of the Snellville United Methodist Church. Roy worked twenty-eight years with Southern Bell and served eighteen years in the Army Reserve. Retirement fueled his desire for other opportunities and he started J and J Sales providing pine straw to landscapers and homeowners throughout the area. He found joy in coaching baseball and softball, spending many hours on the athletic fields. He enjoyed hunting pheasants and rabbits and had lifelong friends that shared this with him. He enjoyed sharing a good story! He was preceded in death by his parents, Nesbit and Jimmie Belle Couch; his son, John Roy Couch; sisters Evelene and Margie; brothers, Neal, M.G., Marlyn, Edgar and Elkin. Mr. Couch is survived by his wife of sixty-three years, Lynette Webb Couch; his children, Susan Lancaster (Gary), Julie Beasley (Glenn), and Jim Couch (Carrie); grandchildren, Jason Lancaster, Katilyn and Jackson King; sisters, Venelle Stanley, Mary Ann Simonton, Edith and W.T.
