Born in Guayaquil, Ecuador, Alfred pursued his medical education at the University of Guayaquil from 1973–1979, where he earned his Doctorate in Medicine. In 1985, he continued his training at Emory University, beginning his residency and eventually building a remarkable career in medicine. Alfred later established his own OB/GYN private practice in Lawrenceville, Georgia, where he faithfully served his patients and community until his retirement in 2021.

Dr. Williams was widely respected for his exceptional surgical skill, compassionate care, calm demeanor, and unwavering dedication to his patients. To many, he was more than a physician — he was a source of comfort, wisdom, and kindness during life's most important moments.

Above all, Alfred was a devoted Christian man whose faith in the Lord guided every aspect of his life. He lived with humility, generosity, grace, and a servant's heart, always striving to reflect God's love in the way he treated others. His relationship with the Lord was the foundation of who he was, and those closest to him found inspiration in his quiet strength, steadfast faith, and compassionate spirit.
