Ed and Anne were not married at the time ,they did go on to marry 6 mos later , but never came back for me. They went on to have my brother Robert and my sister Regina, neither of whom want anything to do with me . I was illegitimate and sullied their image of their mother. I wasn't until I was in my 50's that I made contact with Ed and he confirmed what I already knew. Anne had died at this point and I did get to meet my blood sister and brother. As I have stated , no relationship came from this. I was adopted by a couple who had tried and failed to have a child , they were thrilled with me until my adopted mother got pregnant. hen I was just their adopted child. I had a miserable , lonely life. Never fit in anywhere because of the decision Anne and Ed Ball made.  
Now , I am in my 60's and have a wonderful husband and marriage of nearly a quarter of a century. Everything worked out well for me despite the best efforts of others.  
I write this solemn truth because I have as much right to be acknowledged as any of her other children. She named me Michelle Anne Earley. My name now is Debra Ann Kimelblatt.
