



## Anthea Earls

September 10, 1945 - October 20, 2016

It is with deep regret and a heavy heart, that we would like to announce that Anthea passed away peacefully this past Thursday, October 20, 2016. She was surrounded by loved ones and was not in any pain as she succumb to her very private, 2-year battle with cancer. There is an emphasis on "private"; Anthea's wishes were to keep her illness between immediate family only. She was a remarkably strong woman and never wanted to be viewed as a 'victim' of cancer.

Beloved mother of Ray Jr and Craig and his wife Sharon. Proud grandmother of Siyah, Amun, Cole and Ella. Survived by her sister Georgia and brothers Mikail and Johnathan. Daughter of Viola and late father George Anthony Rogers.

Anthea was born on September 10th, 1945, in Bermuda and was educated at Bermuda High School for Girls. Her career began in radio at the Bermuda Broadcasting Company and continued on to WPLJ Radio, NYC and four networks: NBC and ABC in New York, TBS and CNN in Atlanta. She started out as a Production Assistant/Executive Assistant, and over the years was promoted to Associate Producer, and then Producer and served on the production team of several award-winning, national and international documentaries and CNN news productions. She was also Manager of Newsroom Operations at CNN Headline News--now HLN. Producer, writer,

and post production manager on CNN Earth Matters, and TBS Network Earth programs. She also served on the production team that launched the first 26 episodes of the environmental cartoon, "Captain Planet and the Planetees" which often airs on the Cartoon Network.

Anthea's wishes were for her sons to have a private moment of silence in prayer with her remains after her passing, a memorial in her honor, with her extended family and close friends, in Bermuda.

Most of all Anthea would have wanted for those that remember her to hold her in their hearts and celebrate her life.

The Bermuda memorial date is to be determined.

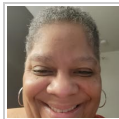
