January 15, 1936 - February 7, 2022

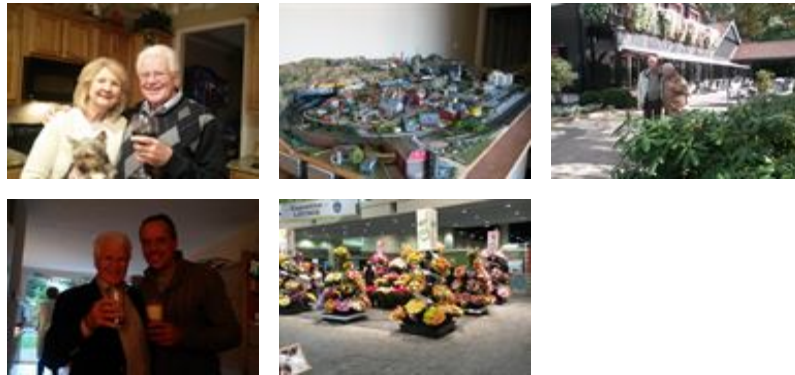
