LEBOWSKI - Barbara Lebowski passed on Monday, April 5, 2010 near her home in Walton County, Georgia in a fatal car accident. Barbara was an independent spirit who led an impassioned life. She was born in Goettingen, Germany to Hedwig Troester and Werner Troester. In 1949, she escaped from East Germany with her mother and sister and moved to the United States in 1961. She later became a U. S. Citizen and was very proud to be an American. During her early adulthood, she lived in New York City, Washington, D.C., Boston and Washington State. She moved to Stone Mountain, Georgia in 1968. She met her husband, David Lebowski in 1982, and they remained together until she passed away. In her professional life, she worked for the Emory University accounting department, later as an interior decorator, and finally as a hotel manager for several years before retiring. Barbara was passionate in all her interests. She loved animals, politics and travel and recently enjoyed a two-week vacation in Paris. She gave generously to anyone she found in need and gave to various charities including Our Lady of the Angels Monastery in Hanceville, Alabama and several animal shelters and causes. She was also fiercely loyal to her family and personally cared for her elderly mother, father-in-law and mother-in-law.
