



## Barbara Jean Rolader

August 29, 1944 - November 7, 2023

ROLADER – Barbara Jean (Anglin) Rolader, age 79 of Loganville, Georgia, passed away of natural causes peacefully on Tuesday, November 7, 2023, after a long battle with Parkinson’s Disease.

Barbara cared deeply for her family, church community, neighbors, and friends. She did this not out of obligation, but because who she was. She loved to cook and host guests in her home.
