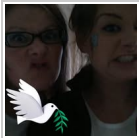
“ To the Stewart family:

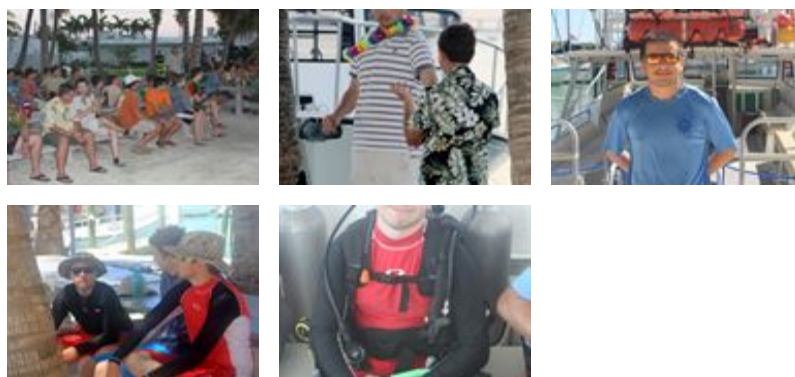
