BROOKS - Bobby C. Brooks, age 86 of Loganville, passed away on Tuesday, January 22, 2019. A Memorial Service will be held at 4 PM on Sunday, February 10, 2019 at Woodlake Baptist Church in Covington (Walnut Grove). Rev. Jerry Grey will officiate. Bobby was born in Mathiston, Mississippi on November 13, 1932 to the late Earnest Vernon Brooks and Mildred Louise Buckingham Brooks. He married Martha Ann Long in May of 1955 and graduated from Dental School at Emory in 1956. Bobby served two years in the United States Army before returning to Decatur to set up his private dental practice. He lived in Tucker and practiced dentistry there for 42 years before retiring and moving to Loganville. Bobby was a member of the Georgia Dental Association (receiving the Honorable Fellow Award in 1982), the American Dental Association, and was a member of Woodlake Baptist Church. He went on many mission trips and worked on the Georgia Baptist Medical/Dental bus to perform dentistry for those less fortunate.
