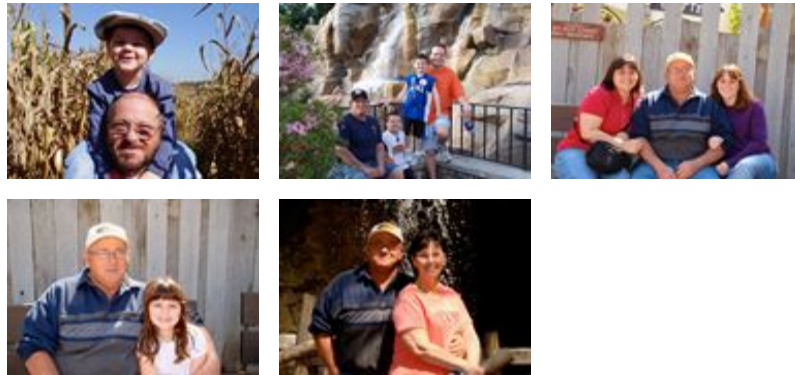

“ I am so sorry to hear of your loss. I knew Bobby through Wayne who was a good friend of my brother David, I remember Bobby being very kind. I also remember his physical strength. I was “turning wrenches” for Wayne with David one Sunday afternoon. Wayne was removing an expensive aluminum intake on his SS Camaro. Something needed to be done & he was going to put it back on after. The 3 of us could not get the intake to budge. We had removed the bolts, but still nothing. Wayne called Bobby outside to help. Bobby asked him several times if he had removed all the bolts & Wayne assured him he had. After several attempts to pull it off, Bobby got up over the motor & got a good grip on the intake and gave a huge jerk. We heard a metallic “ping” as the intake came off in Bobby’s hands. Two bolts on one corner had not been removed first. Bobby broke it off with brute strength. Of course Wayne got a tongue-lashing for not being sure all the bolts had been removed. Which he really didn’t need since his very expensive new intake was now useless. Later Bobby was supportive for Wayne. We occasionally needed Bobby after that and he was always there.
