“ I worked with Bobby at my daddy's shop for a short time. One day, he came in telling us how he had picked up a scared young lady whose car had broken down on 985. I explained to him that he better reconsider such kindness to strangers. A few days later, my sister-in-law, Christi, told me about how her car had broken down on 985. A stranger had stopped, picked her up, and dropped her at the nearest service station. This was before cell phones, of course. Putting two and two together, I figured out that Bobby had picked up Christi. Bobby said he just felt an obligation to pick up the stranded woman before someone with bad intentions did so, and Christi explained that she felt at peace with getting in the car with Bobby, a complete stranger. They both explained how they sat as far away from each other as possible and did not talk to each other for fear of scaring the other.

Bobby was friendly, had a great sense of humor, and was an amazing mechanic. He said it best when he described himself as "being able to fix anything from a broken heart to a broken shoestring."
