BROWN, Boyd Dewitt "Buster" Brown was born on the Island of St. Thomas in the United States Virgin Islands on January 4th 1956 to Warren E. Brown and Eugenia E. Brown nee Stridiron. He attended the Sts. Peter and Paul Catholic Grammar School and Graduated from Charlotte Amalie High School. Shortly after graduation he enlisted in the U.S. Army and was stationed in Korea and Texas from 1976 to 1978. He lived in Las Vegas for a while after being honorably discharged from the Army and returned to the family home on St. Thomas. He attended the University of the Virgin Islands where he took courses in Accounting and Business Administration. He worked at the Department of Finance of St. Thomas for approximately four years and then became a Firefighter with the Fire Service where he served for 20 plus years, was promoted to Deputy Fire Chief and retired as such in 2005. He was a member of a softball team on St. Thomas, a member of the National Guard and during several summers organized basketball camps for youngsters in the Savan area. "Buster" as he was affectionately called by all his friends and relatives, married his sweetheart of nineteen years, Blondelle, on December 21, 1999. After Buster's early retirement and his failing health, they moved to Loganville, Georgia.
