ADKISON, Britt L. – Britt L. Adkison, age 87 of Loganville, Georgia, passed away Thursday, December 9, 2016 while in hospice care. He was born and raised in Gadsden County Florida but lived most of his life in Albany Georgia. Britt served in the United States Air Force for six years and during that time he married his childhood sweetheart, Loraine Tidwell, while stationed at MacDill Air Force Base in Tampa. Shortly thereafter, Britt was sent to Hunter Air Base in Savannah, Georgia where his first daughter, Linda, was born. He and his small family then moved to Albany to serve at Turner Field. A couple years later, he was honorably discharged from the Air Force. After leaving the USAF, Britt began on-the-job-training under the GI Bill to become a plumber. He trained 5 years as an Apprentice, then obtained his license as a Master Plumber. During this time his second daughter, Lisa, was born. At the age of 34, Britt started Britt's Plumbing and Heating Company which he owned and operated for over 30 years with Loraine as his business partner. When Britt and Loraine retired, they sold their business, their home and most of their belongings to travel throughout the United States, including Alaska, and through most of Canada in their RV. After 3 ½ years, they decided to settle in Loganville to be close to both their girls. Britt was preceded in death by his daughter, Linda A. Williams, and his loving wife of almost 65 years, Loraine Adkison. He is survived by his daughter, Lisa and her husband, Art Hallock, and son-in-law John S. (Sandy) Williams all of Loganville, Georgia; his only

grandchild, Jessica W. Griffin married to Joel H. Griffin and their children (Britt's 2 great-grandsons), Joel Harris Griffin, Jr. and John Irvin Griffin, all of Milledgeville, Georgia. The family will receive friends 3:00-6:00 PM Monday, December 12, 2016 at Tim Stewart Funeral Home, 2246 Wisteria Drive, Snellville, Georgia 30078.
