Minister Adam Turner, Minister Don Hardison & Minister Josh Moore will officiate. Mr. Adair was preceded in death by his father, James Thomas Adair, III, and his step-mother, Joyce Shirley. Brooks and his wife, Michelle "Shelby" Rene Adair, were married on July 24, 1999 but were together a total of 23 wonderful years. 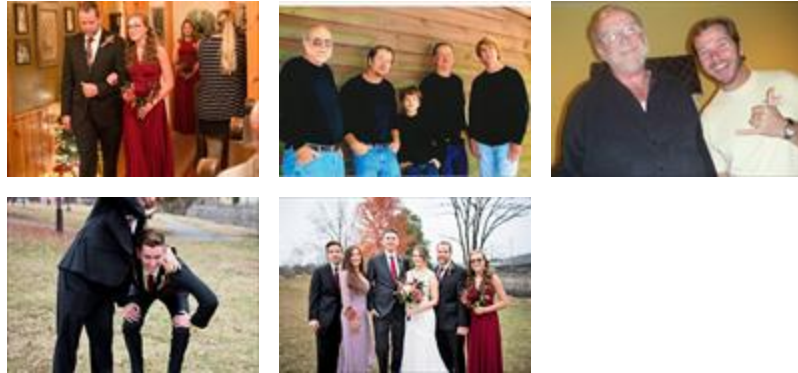
