Cameron Violet (Smith) Pew was born on October 13, 1989 in Ft. Worth, Texas, and departed this life to be with her Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, on June 18, 2026 at the age of 36. Though she lived most of her life in Georgia, because she lived in Texas until her early teen years, she considered herself a Texan first.

Camie graduated from Chapel Hill High School in Douglasville, Georgia in 2008. Following high school she attended and earned her Bachelors Degree with honors from the University of West Georgia in 2012 with a degree in Education. She went on to earn her Masters Degree in Education from Piedmont College in 2015. After college she began her career as an elementary school teacher

In November 2013 Camie was set up on a blind date with the man who would become the love of her life, Nathan Pew. Nathan and Camie were married on April 4, 2015 and the new couple moved to Dacula, Georgia. Three years later, in March 2018, when their first daughter, Eliana, was born, Camie left teaching to take up her calling as a wife and mother. By God's providence and blessing, Nathan and Camie's second daughter, Madilyn, was born two years later, in February 2020.

Camie came to know the Lord and was baptized as a young teen and began

her Christian journey. Camie was blessed to have a God-fearing husband who nurtured and loved his wife as Christ loves the church. Camie was a gifted and skilled Bible group leader and teacher and valued friend.
