January 1, 1933 - April 22, 2014

Carl L Locke, Sr passed away April 22 at age 81 after a brief illness. Services will be held in his honor on Monday April 28 at 3 PM at the Tim Stewart Chapel in Snellville. He was one of seven children born on a small farm in rural Warren County, Tennessee to Daniel and Mazel Locke on New Years Day 1933. Born into a house without electricity he would go on to lead an extraordinary life. After graduating high school, he served in Korea during the Korean conflict as a member of the signal corps. He returned to lead two careers that each lasted 20 years. The first was the shoe industry that would take him first to Mississippi and then to Pennsylvania and on to the Caribbean. The second was the textile industry that would bring him to Snellville, Georgia where he lived for the past 41 years. During those years he traveled extensively all over North and Central America. In 1957 he married Linda Wray Dodd, the love of his life. They were married for 57 years and had three children: Carl Jr (Rae Anne) of Westport, Ct, Charles Daniel (Cheryl) of Hoschton, and Robin Renay Tatum (Zach) of Birmingham, Alabama; and four grandchildren: Kyle Lee Tatum of Birmingham, Alabama, Eric Drew Tatum of Atlanta, Samuel Aubrey Locke of New York City and Trevor Owen Locke of Westport, Ct. Two sisters also survive: Laverne Ours of Smithville, Tennessee and Nelda Turner of Chattanooga, Tennessee. He was preceded in death by three older brothers: Howard, Aubrey and DW and one sister, Sally Jo Cope. Born a farmer and always a farmer, he loved his very large gardens and especially his tomatoes, which he gifted to many neighbors and friends over

the years. He also had a love for fishing and enjoyed spending time on the lake with friends and family. He was a member of the Lawrenceville Church of Christ and the Veterans of Foreign Wars.
