In August 1994, Carol and Ron moved permanently to Ocala, Florida where she lived until her death. After moving to Ocala, Carol volunteered at the Marion County Hospital for many years, but her true passion was training her miniature poodles. She trained and showed more than 10 poodles. Her show career started at the Suffolk Obedience Training Club with her poodle Muffin. When she moved to Florida, she joined the Marion Alachua Dog Training Association where she was a trainer. She was also quite a competitor in obedience and agility with her OTCH dog Abby and UDX dog Gidget. She was also a dog show steward and a rally judge. Her remaining poodle Timmy

has been her faithful companion for the last two years and was with her when she passed away. Carol was a loving wife, mother, grandmother, sister, aunt, and friend. She was friendly, kind, and generous. She will be missed by many.
