CROWE – Charles Marion Crowe, Jr., age 78 of Grayson, Georgia, passed away on Sunday, December 7, 2025. A combined Funeral Service for both he and his recently deceased wife of four days, Jill Orr-Crowe, will be held at 1:00 pm on Thursday, December 18, 2025, in the Lawrenceville Chapel of Tim Stewart Funeral Home, with their dear friend Mr. Luke Lenahan officiating. He worked hard to provide for his family, whom he cared for deeply. He would come home from a long day at work and help in the care of his handicapped daughter, while also spending quality time with his son. In Charles' early career, he served two years as a Sargent and Company Clerk in the United States Army and continued his service for eight more years in the Army Reserves. He was highly regarded in the Army and had secret military clearance that he could not even share with his wife. Charles' life career of over 40 years was spent as a Master Plumber, licensed in residential, commercial, nuclear and medical gasses. He was one of the top in his field

and called upon to supervise the installation of medical gas lines at several leading hospitals in Atlanta, GA and several nuclear power plants along the East Coast. Charles was a member of the United Association Local Union 72 Plumbers, Pipefitters & HVACR Technicians for over 50 years. Throughout the years, Charles and his wife opened their home, taking in and helping several family members. He was always willing to lend a hand to family and friends in need without hesitation. Charles and his wife were members of American Legion Post 264, where he would often help at events. Charles was quiet and small in stature but his heart was huge and spoke volumes. Charles will be greatly missed by those who love him. He is now at peace, surrounded once again by his loving family.
