MARQUIS, CHARLES (CHUCK)-Charles T. Marquis, age 83 of Lawrenceville passed into the Lords grace surrounded by family July 9, 2009 following a courageous battle with cancer. He was born on July 24, 1925 in Detroit, Michigan. A son of a miller, "Chuck" grew up in Van Buren, Maine. He was a pipefitter by trade for most of his life, and had worked in the building industry since 1939 and was a lifetime member of U. A. Pipefitters & Steamfitters L. U. 582 in Santa Ana, California. He was a homebuilder in Lawrenceville after moving there in 1982 but will be best remembered as a familiar figure in his crumpled fishing hat as the City of Lawrenceville Building Inspector for several years beginning in 1986. Known as "Chucky-Baby" to many, he will be fondly remembered for his gentle personality and sense of humor. He was preceded in death by his wife, Freda Marquis.
