travel back there one day to scatter her ashes. In addition to all of this Christy was an avid reader, a talented artist, and loved to write in her journals. 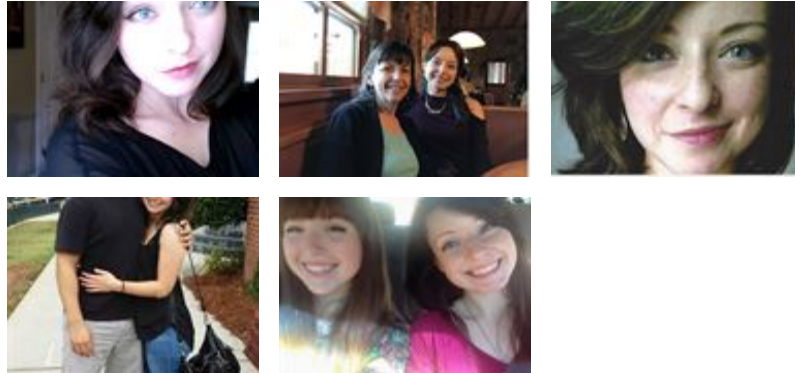

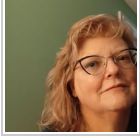
