AYERS – Mr. Clinton Ayers, age 57 of Loganville, passed away on Wednesday, October 26, 2016. Funeral Services will be held at 11 AM on Saturday, October 29, 2016 at the Victory Baptist Church. Rev. Josh Ayers, Steven Ayers, and Chris (Jethro) Waye will officiate. Burial will follow at Corinth Memorial Gardens in Loganville. Mr. Ayers was a 1977 graduate of Loganville High School, a member of Victory Baptist Church for 27 years where he was a Sunday school teacher, former deacon, and part of the RU program. He retired from Gwinnett County, where he was in charge of traffic signals, after 30 years. Mr. Ayers was Commissioner of District One in Walton County for 14 years and was a charter member of the Loganville Rotary Club. He was a Veteran of the United States Army and retired as a Sergeant Major in the Army Reserves. Mr. Ayers was preceded in death by his mother, Vaneda Ayers, in 2011. 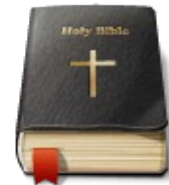
