



Coach Phil Hall

July 5, 1948 - December 26, 2019

Hall – Coach Phil Hall, age 71 of Dacula, passed away on Thursday, December 26, 2019. A funeral service will be held at 3:00 PM, Sunday, December 29, 2019 at Hebron Baptist Church, with Rev. Larry Wynn and Dustin Wilbanks officiating. The burial will follow at Pleasant Hill Cemetery, 1800 Fence Road, Dacula, GA. Coach Hall was an Army veteran of the Vietnam era and a member of Hebron Baptist Church. He was a coach and teacher with Gwinnett County Public Schools, where he retired after 31 years. He was a member of the Athletic Hall of Fame for Dacula and North Gwinnett High Schools. He was inducted into the Winningest Basketball Coaches of GA. He was Vice President of Gwinnett County Farm Bureau, he served on the Board of Directors and was a member of the Barrow Gwinnett Cattlemen's Association. At Hebron he served as an usher, Connect Group co-leader for the DOVES class, and was team leader for the Montana Mission Trip each summer. He was also a longtime Big Dog Bible Study Leader. He was preceded in death by his parents, Reuben & Louise Hall; and mother-in-law, Margie Lindsay. He is survived by his loving wife of 44 years, Diane Lindsay Hall, Dacula; God-daughter & husband, Amanda Whiteshield-Lomax & Aaron Brinkman, Dacula; brothers & sister-in-law, Kenneth & Janice Hall, Dacula; Mark Hall, Dacula; sister, Sheila Pittman, Dacula; father-in-law, Winford Lindsay; brothers-in-law & sisters-in-law, Buck & Cindy Lindsay, Duluth; Chris & Elizabeth Lindsay, Ashburn, VA; 20 nieces & nephews; and 16 great nieces & nephews.
