BOSS – Col. Luther Donald Boss, USAF, Ret., age 84 of Loganville, passed away on Sunday, April 9, 2017. A Cryptside Service will be held on Wednesday, April 12, 2017 at 12 PM in the Mausoleum of East Shadowlawn Memorial Gardens, Lawrenceville, with Military Honors. Col. Boss was a 1949 graduate of Loganville High School and a 1953 graduate of the University of Georgia where he graduated with a Bachelor’s Degree in Education. He entered the United States Air Force in 1954 and retired in 1979 as a Colonel with several commendations including the Air Force Cross and the Bronze Star. Col. Boss taught Industrial Arts at Loganville High School for 4 years and was a real estate sales and developer. He operated the Deep Wood Christmas Tree & Catfish Farms. Col. Boss was a member of the American Legion Post 233 in Loganville and loved to travel in his later years. He was preceded in death by his parents, Luther G. “Bo” & Sara Smith Boss. Col.
