



COL (R) Robert M. Galloway

June 1, 1921 - July 10, 2016

Galloway – (Ret.) Colonel Robert M. Galloway, age 95 of Snellville, passed away on Sunday, July 10, 2016. Graveside services will be held at 12:30 PM, Friday, July 15, 2016 at Georgia National Cemetery, Canton, GA with full military honors. Chaplin CPT Bellemay will officiate. Col. Galloway was a family man, husband and a patriot. He was born on a farm near Corwith, Iowa on June 1, 1921. He was the son of the late Robert Joseph Galloway and Gertrude Mattoon Galloway and baptized at the Methodist Church in Corwith in October 1921. He graduated from high school at Ames, Iowa and from Roosevelt University in Chicago. Lt. Galloway and Dorothy Orene Huntley were married on June 2, 1945 in the Methodist Church in Spartanburg, South Carolina. Col. Galloway served with distinction in a variety of assignments in the United States and Overseas. He was drafted into the Army in 1942. He attended OCS and was commissioned in July 1943. During the Korean War, he was assigned as the S3 of the 2nd Battalion of the 31st Infantry Regiment, 7th Infantry Division. After duty in the 3rd Infantry Division at Ft. Benning and Germany, he attended the Command and General Staff College in 1961-1962. He was then assigned to the Operations Directorate of the Army Staff. A second tour in Korea followed as a Battalion Commander in the 7th Infantry Division. In 1971-1972, he served in Vietnam on the staff of John Paul Vann. On his return to the U.S., he was assigned to Ft. Jackson, SC where he retired in 1974. Col. Galloway's decorations included the Combat Infantry Badge, the Legion of Merit with cluster, the Bronze Star and the Vietnamese

Cross of Gallantry with Palm. Following his retirement, he was elected four times to the Forest Acres City Council (S.C.). He was also a five gallon blood donor to the Red Cross. Col. Galloway was a proud member of the Greatest Generation. In 2002, he and his wife moved to Snellville, Georgia and was a member of Cannon Methodist Church. Surviving Col. Galloway is his wife of 71 years, Dorothy Galloway; his daughter Eva Linda Lins of Snellville; son Robert Huntley Galloway of Lilburn; grandchildren: Christopher Daniel (Shannon) Lins, Laura Rachel (Kevin) Kruger, Sara Beth (Shannon) Amos, Robert Huntley (Christina) Galloway, Jr., Ryan James (Margaux) Galloway and 6 great grandchildren.
