LOWRY, CPL JOSEPH CASON JR. - CPL Joseph Cason Lowry, Jr., (Casey), age 25 of Lawrenceville, passed away Wednesday, July 14, 2010 after a 3 year battle with cancer. Funeral Services will be held 11:00 AM, Friday, July 23, 2010 in the Lawrenceville Chapel of Tim Stewart Funeral Home with Rev. Grady Mosley officiating. Born 6 weeks early on August 16, 1984, Casey came into this world much as he departed it, fighting to stay on this earth. Casey was on active duty in the USMC, and was a lifelong resident of Lawrenceville, GA. He was a 2002 graduate of Dacula High School and a Master Mason in the Lawrenceville Lodge No 131 F & AM. He was preceded in death by his grandmother, Carolyn Brown and his uncle, Scott Brown. 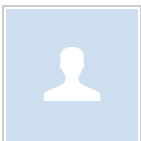
I had some friends that were taken from me in Combat and it still makes me think of people like you. Their is nobody who wants to leave this part of our life at such a young age.

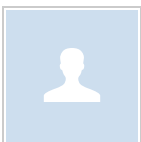

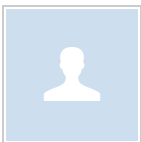
