Cyrus Johnson Wilson, Jr., age 88 of Loganville, GA died August 12, 2009 with his family at his side. Mr. Wilson was born January 27, 1921 in Mint Hill, NC to Cyrus J. Wilson and Laura Dixie Beard Wilson. He was a graduate of Davidson College and a veteran of World War II, serving in the United States Army Air Forces, Pacific Theater of Operations. Mr. Wilson retired from Mack Truck Company in 1986 after 40 years of faithful service. At various times, Mr. Wilson served as elder, deacon and Sunday School teacher in the Presbyterian Church.
