



## Daniel M Fenwick

October 6, 1971 - January 25, 2021

Daniel Fenwick is originally from Maryland and is survived by his wife, Jovita, and their four beautiful children, Angel, Donovan, Xavier, and Faith. Daniel's true passion was for his wife and children...the FENWICK6. He is also survived by his father and stepmother, Daniel and Sharon Fenwick; his mother and stepfather, Rose & Ron Finney; his brother, Theron Fenwick; his sisters, Taneka Little and Leslie Chase; several aunts, uncles, cousins, nieces and nephews; and A LOT of friends and co-workers turned friends.

Daniel enlisted in the Army in 1992 as a 13B, Cannon Crewmember, aka an "Artilleryman." He served honorably with many units including 2/29 Field Artillery (FA); 1/37 FA; 4-319th Airborne Field Artillery Regiment; the 101st Airborne Division; the 173d Airborne Brigade; 1st Brigade, 1st Armored Division; and USASMA. He earned his Airborne wings, became a Jumpmaster, a Senior Air Assault Instructor and later a Pathfinder. He deployed twice to Afghanistan and once to Iraq, earning two Bronze Stars. Daniel retired from the United States Army in 2012 at Ft. Bliss, TX, after 20 years of dedicated service to the nation.

Daniel never met a stranger

Daniel loved working with children considered at risk and assisting his fellow Veterans and Spouses to successfully transition out of the military. Because of his gentle spirit and genuine concern for others, people regularly sought Daniel out for advice, guidance, and mentorship. Dan and Jovita coached and mentored engaged couples and couples in distress through the church and

their small business. He was also a member of the Juvenile Diversion Program in Thurston County, WA, as well as a member of the Gwinnett County Youth Diversion Program, GA. He volunteered at each church his family attended from Destiny Family Christian Center in El Paso, TX, Capital Christian Center in Lacey, WA, to Victory World Church in Norcross, GA. Dan also packaged and delivered food to low-income seniors in Gwinnett County with Mending the Gap. He enjoyed cars and motorcycles and going to every car show he could. He also loved dancing, listening to music, and singing songs that were always in his head. He would always say, "Just dance to the song that's in your head."

Daniel Marcellus Fenwick, 49, passed away on Monday, January 25, 2021. A celebration of life will be held 11:00 a.m., Tuesday, February 9, 2021 in the Lawrenceville Chapel of Tim Stewart Funeral Home. 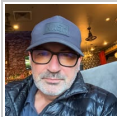

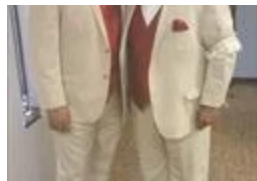
