Dave had three children with his first wife: Dana (1971), Rachel (1976), and Ashley (1981). He had two children, Daven (1998) and Ciera (2005) with his wife, Cheri Hall. He cherished coaching and teaching his kids

baseball, basketball, tennis, golf, and horseback riding. He was their biggest supporter. He also loved his many pets over the years.

After 35 years he left Willowbend and moved to Ga. Same story with his kids, sports and being involved. 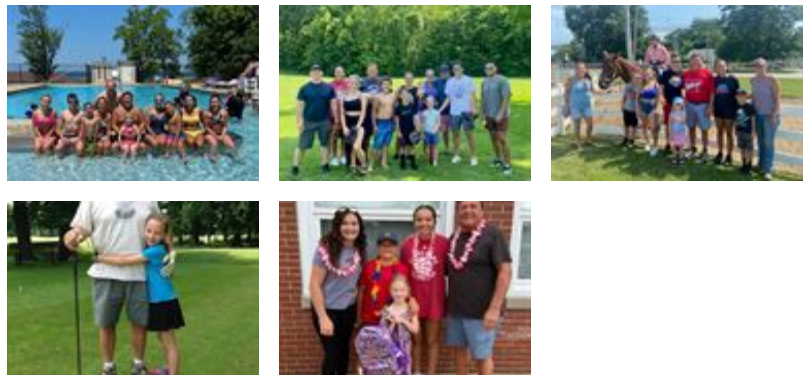
