

## David J. Forte

February 28, 1966 - December 18, 2015

David Joseph Forte, father, son, brother and friend, age 49, of Statham, Georgia passed away Friday December 18, 2015 after a courageous battle with colon cancer. David lived a full life and was taken away from us much too early. David asked that in lieu of flowers that donations be considered for colorectal cancer research, specifically for people diagnosed under the age of 50.

He grew up in Snellville, Georgia and attended South Gwinnett High School.

David was a store manager for Rite Aide drug stores for over 25 years and was well liked and respected by everyone he worked with and for. His job was very important to him and his dedication showed in his passion for working long and stressful hours. David touched the lives of the people he worked with, being not only their co-worker but also their friend, their confidant, and a mentor to many.

David enjoyed working on his cars and trucks and had vast knowledge of motor vehicles and of his collection of guns. He could take guns apart, repair and restore them like a professional.

He is survived by his parents, Richard and Suzanne Forte of Monroe, Ga., son, Joshua Forte of Winder, Ga., sister and brother-in-law Shelly and John

Thiemann of Walnut Grove, niece and nephew Blake and Dana Thiemann of Walnut Grove; grandmother, Anne Dana of Monroe, uncle, Paul Forte of Palmetto, Georgia, aunts Betty Lee of Richland Hills, Texas and Jackie Farnschlader of Media, PA and a host of cousins and friends.

Services honoring David's life will be held Monday December 21, 2015 at 1:00 PM in the Chapel of Tim Stewart Funeral Home, 209 S. Hammond Drive Monroe, Ga. 30655 and the Reverend George O. Rogers officiating. The family will arrive at 12:30 PM to receive friends until service time. Family will have a private comital service.

A celebration of life and luncheon will be held afterwards at The First Presbyterian Church in Monroe, 500 Breedlove Dive, Monroe, GA 30655. All friends and family are invited to attend. Per David's request, everyone in attendance should dress casually.
