He loved all things with a motor, from racing Formula 440 cars, flying his Rockwell Commander airplane or R22 helicopter, restoring classic cars, riding motorcycles, or taking a bit of a slower speed on the water, relaxing with oldies music playing on one of his many boats throughout the years. Instead of collecting trinkets, he collected cars, most frequently Corvettes, owning over 128 in his lifetime, a 1971 Cutlass Convertible that he restored, as well as many others, but the crown jewels of his collection were his DeTomaso Panteras.

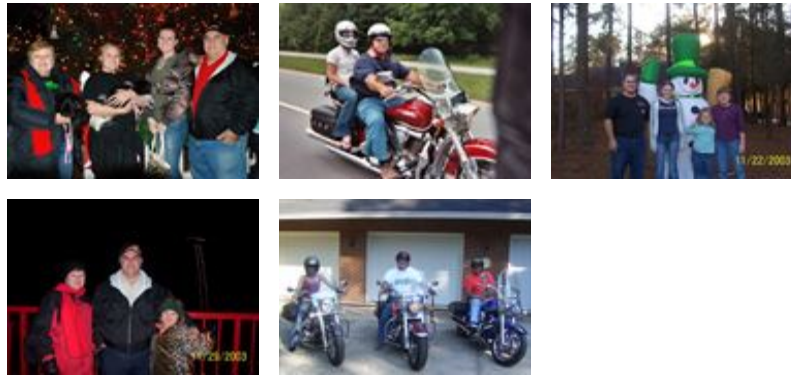
