Donald "Ray" Clark, age 72 of Dacula, passed away on Wednesday, November 11, 2020. 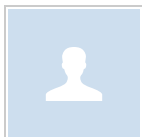

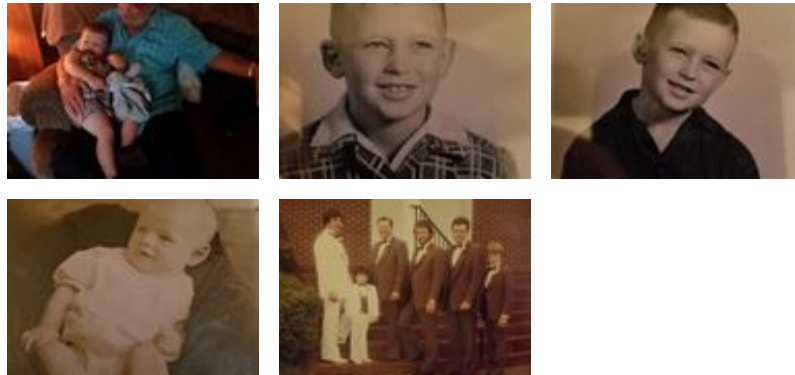
