Lockhart – Dorothy H. Lockhart of Atlanta, GA died Monday, June 13, 2011 after a long illness. She is survived by her loving husband of 66 years, James H. Lockhart, and her sons Robert S. Lockhart and William L. Lockhart.

Dorothy was born in Meadville, PA and moved to Miami, FL with her older sister after high school graduation. There she worked for the FBI during WWII until marrying Navy Lieutenant Lockhart.
