“ Harvell and I shared a house or apartment in Atlanta for several years--until I got married in 1968. I still saw him occasionally--but, eventually, lost touch.

Harvell and another guy started to 'cut grass' while he was at BP as a way to earn extra cash. This effort became a landscaping business. Many of its customers were in the Buckhead area of Atlanta--including properties along West Paces Ferry Road near the Governor's Mansion.

The landscaping business became so successful that it had to buy machinery and to hire help. Harvell quit BP, sold his share and opened his own cabinet business.

He could also pitch a baseball very well. I once saw him strike out 27 batters in a row in a semi-pro game.

Judy met him at a Class Reunion but instantly liked him. He instructed me to call him "Doug".

The last times we saw him were at Class Reunions. He recalled "old times" in front of Judy. The result of his reminiscence was that we agreed that "it seemed to be a good idea at the time."

Harvell "Doug" Trice was a stand up guy.

Everybody remembers the same great guy I knew. I am so glad to have been his friend.

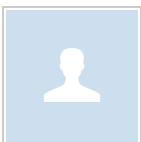
