Eileen Martha Fair-Womble was born in Elizabeth, New Jersey on November 3, 1943. On January 30, 2022, she made her departure from this life into the Presence of the Lord.

Among the amazing attributes her life exemplified, one was her demonstration of the value of education. She attended Union High School of Union, New Jersey. Graduating in 1961. She distinguished herself to demonstrate a high proficiency in the areas of dance, gymnastics and art. Many awards and honors were accorded her...CBS offered to place her and her sister, Toni Lampley, under contract for various television appearances-an opportunity that was declined due to her thirst for education.

In 1963, she attended Middlesex County Vocational and Technical School of Woodbridge, NJ and became a Licensed Practical Nurse. Upon graduating she was offered a prestigious position to become the New Jersey State representative for LPNs to serve on the State Board of Nursing. She declined the appointment to focus upon the care of her children.

Her nursing career continued to escalate and brought her into various dimensions of expertise. She excelled as a bedside nurse, but also distinguished herself in various administrative aspects of nursing with Blue Cross/Blue Shield of New Jersey.

In 1980, she attended Middlesex County College to earn her Associates Degree and became a Registered Nurse. Her career continued to flourish until her retirement in 2019.

Nursing is a Divine Calling, and Eileen abided in her calling, sacrificially serving humanity with compassion and grace for over 53 years. Sacrifice was the all-encompassing theme of her life.
