CLIFTON, ELDRIDGE H "CLIFF"- Eldridge H. "Cliff" Clifton, age 88 of Lawrenceville, passed away Sunday, May 23, 2010. Memorial Service will be held at 11:00 AM, Thursday, May 27, 2010 at Lawrenceville Presbyterian Church with Reverend Paul Ard officiating. Mr. Clifton was a veteran in the United States Air Force during WWII, earning a Bronze Star for his service. He retired as a Regional Vice-President of Ryder Truck Lines after 32 years, working in Jacksonville, Florida for many years and then later in Atlanta. His years at Ryder brought him life-long friends that he cherished long after his retirement. Cliff was happy married to Dorothy Westmoreland Clifton for 63 years. Together they enjoyed participating in various church activities, volunteering their time at Gwinnett Medical Center and spending time with their children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren. One of Cliff and Dot's most enjoyable activities was traveling extensively throughout the United States, especially to Alaska and Hawaii. Cliff was an avid deep-sea fisherman, and spent much leisure time in Stuart, Florida. Cliff was a true Southern Gentleman, always courteous and with a kind word to all he came in contact with. He was a member of Lawrenceville Presbyterian Church, and preceded in death by his wife Dorothy Westmoreland Clifton.
