CUNNINGHAM, ELEANOR GREBE - Eleanor Grebe Cunningham died on Tuesday, January 20, 2009 in her 91st year. She had lived in Dacula, Georgia for the last 10 years with her daughter Mary Eleanor and her son-in-law John Ligertwood. She was predeceased by her husband Eppy Newton Cunningham, Jr. in 1980.
