Ellen Langley Day, age 84, of Monroe, Georgia, passed away peacefully on May 13, 2025.

Ellen was born on September 26, 1940, in Grayson, Georgia to Carter and Thelma Langley. She grew up in Decatur, Georgia where she attended Murphy High School and then graduated from Decatur High School. She always looked forward to attending reunions from both schools and enjoyed seeing her high school friends. After graduating from high school, she married her high school sweetheart, William Day and began a long career as a paralegal in Atlanta and retired after working for C. Lawrence Jewett, Atlanta. She was an active member of Snellville Christian Church and First Baptist Church of Snellville where she was involved in the church choir, women's ministry, children's ministry and preschool ministry. She loved singing in the choir where she spent hours rehearsing for the upcoming Christmas Cantata. She will be most remembered as a loving volunteer in the children's and pre-school ministries. She was fondly referred to as "Miss Ellen" by all the children she had the privilege of teaching and leading in Sunday School, Vacation Bible School and Awana Clubs.

She was actively involved and a founding member of the Nob Hill Garden Club in Snellville, Georgia and was a member of the Daughters of the American Revolution (DAR) chapter in Lawrenceville, Georgia. The DAR led to her hobby of genealogy – she loved researching and tracing her family history back to Gwinnett County, Colonial America and the Revolutionary War.

Most importantly, she was a devoted wife, mother, grandmother, great grandmother and friend. She adored “Her William,” daughter Donna, grandchildren Ashleigh, Will, Carter and her beloved great grandsons. 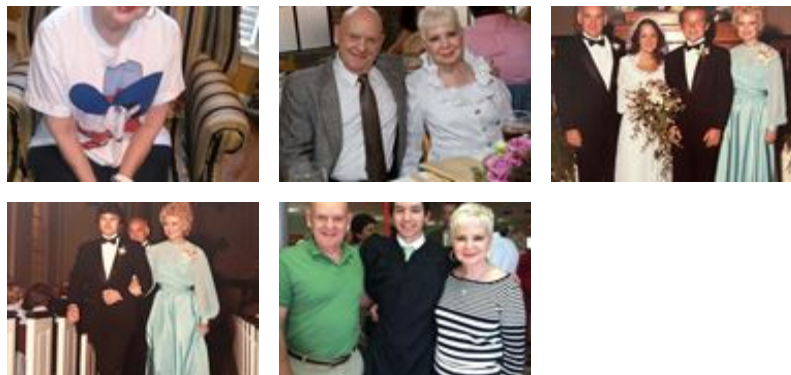
