DIXON- Enid Maud Dixon, 77 year old mother of one son, David Maxwell Dixon, transitioned peacefully surrounded by family at Gwinnett Medical Center on Friday, August 23, 2019 after enduring chronic illness of the heart and lungs for many years. Ms. Enid dedicated her life to helping others in her career, as well as in her personal life. Ms. Enid worked as a Housekeeper after immigrating to the United States from Jamaica with her young son. Motivated to improve her life, Ms. Enid pursued the necessary education to become a Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA), and then worked as a CNA at Preakness Healthcare Center for over 26 years (October 1979 to January 2006), at which time she retired and relocated from New Jersey to Georgia. Ms. Enid will always be remembered for her strength, her generous nature, kind heart, her unrelenting commitment to her family and friends, being a hard worker, and her candid honesty...or some might say “her sassiness” or “sharp tongue”...as she is known for telling it like it is. Funeral Services will be held at 11:00 AM on Saturday, September 7, 2019 in the Lawrenceville Chapel of Tim Stewart Funeral Home. Interment will follow at Gwinnett Memorial Park. 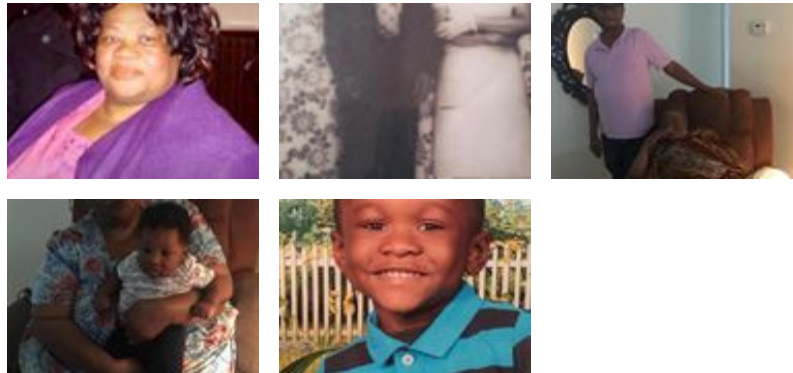
