June 27, 1929 - January 7, 2021

IRVIN – Eugenia (Genie) Irvin, age 91 of Loganville, passed away on Thursday, January 7, 2021. Funeral Services will be held at 2:00 PM on Wednesday, January 13, 2021 in the Loganville Chapel of Tim Stewart Funeral Home. Pastor Pat McCoy and Rev. Jimmy Cason will officiate. Interment will follow at Corinth Memorial Gardens. The family will receive friends from 1:00 – 1:45 PM before the service. Genie was born on June 27, 1929 in Brooklet, Georgia (near Statesboro). She was the youngest of three daughters of Lester and Mamie Alderman. Her father owned the local grocery store in Brooklet and sold everything from a two penny nail to a loaf of bread. Her mother was a homemaker and took care of the children. Growing up Genie enjoyed roller skating, jumping rope, and going to the movies with her best friend Betty. After graduating from Brooklet High School, where she was a cheerleader for the basketball team, she attended Georgia Teacher's College in Statesboro. With her parents' permission, she moved to Atlanta in her late teens to live with her sister and went to work for Sun Life Insurance Company. Shortly thereafter, she met Langley Irvin and on their first date they went to the now world famous Varsity in downtown Atlanta. They were married on June 18, 1950 and were married for 57 years until Langley's passing in 2008. Genie was a member of Atlanta Primitive Baptist Church and in addition to her husband, she was preceded in death by her sisters, Mary Woodall and Margaret Cox. She is survived by her son & girlfriend, Les Irvin & Virginia Hill of Loganville; grandchildren, Matthew Readling & fiancé Mallory Beach of

Pensacola, FL, Jennifer & Mike Morgan of Germany, Lesleigh Irvin of Atlanta; great grandchildren, Max Readling and Everett Morgan. I just FaceTimed (due to Covid) my 92-year old mother, Emily Lucille Kennedy Cravens, to let her know of her sweet cousin Genie's passing because, after several years of occasional searches, I finally reached out to Lesleigh last night, and was so sad to learn of her recent passing. I know that Genie had been like a sister to my mom her in younger years. In fact, that is my mom next to Genie in the photo where she is feeding the wedding cake to Langley, and, we believe, on the very far right of the larger wedding party photo. Mom had told me that she was in Genie's wedding, but I had never seen photos until today. Mom wanted me to tell you that they had a lot of fun together in their "growing up" years, especially playing in Brooklet (Mom lived in Statesboro), where Uncle Lester's grocery store was. Uncle Jim (hardware store owner) and Aunt Stella (wife to Uncle Felix, mill owner) were also in Brooklet, so there were many places for them to get together.

And years later, when my brother, Lee, and I visited our grandparents in Statesboro with our parents, it was always a special treat to make a detour to go visit Genie, Langley and Les. They were always so warm and welcoming to us.

And, as for me, I think my love for my own cousins, and my encouragement for my kids to stay close to theirs comes from knowing how very special that Genie and the other cousins were to Mom. The last time we saw them (Langley, Genie, and Les) was sometime in the '70's I believe, when they had to come to Oklahoma City on business. Mom and Genie laughed until they cried about old stories, and I regret that I was not writing any of them down! If Covid has taught us anything, it is the value of staying close to those we love.

Our thoughts and prayers go out to all of your family at the loss of your very special mom and grandmother. May God hold you closely

during this difficult time, and bless you with peace, comfort, and a lifetime of precious memories. What a grand reunion there must be in heaven right now!

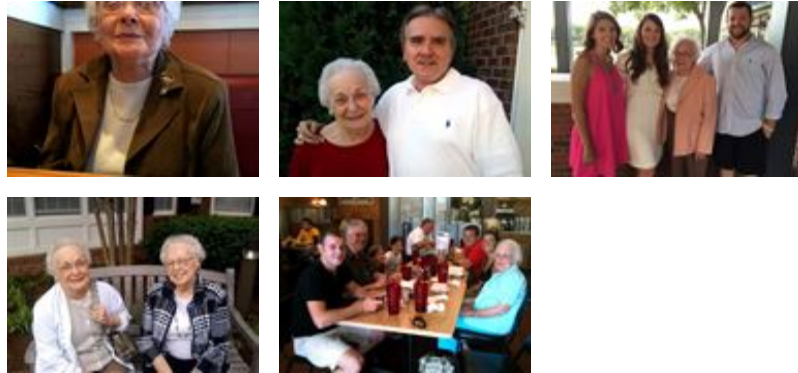
