CAMP – Evelyn Lucille (Kilgore) Camp, age 78 of Oxford, GA, passed into the arms of Jesus on Saturday, October 11, 2025 surrounded by her loved ones. A Celebration of Evelyn’s life will be held at 1:00 PM on Wednesday, October 15, 2025 at Victory Baptist Church, 150 Clark McCullers Drive, Loganville, GA, where she was member since 2015. Pastor Derik Lawrence will be officiating with Preacher Joe Torres and Pastor Josh Ayers participating. The family will receive friends from 11:30 AM – 1:00 PM prior to the service at the church. The youngest of six, and the only daughter, Evelyn, a beloved wife, mother, sister, and “nana” was born and raised in the Rosebud community until moving to Loganville at the age of 19. A few months prior, at the age of 18, she accepted Jesus Christ as her Lord and Savior. Her first job was at Walton Clothes, but she followed her dream of becoming a hairdresser and was a gifted cosmetologist for 53 years, from 1972 until her (sickness forced) retirement in 2025. She worked in the Snellville and Loganville areas, including owning her own beauty salon for over 25 years. She was indeed a hard worker at any task at hand, practically unable to sit down and stay still, always cleaning, cooking, caretaking of others, or styling someone’s hair. She loved keeping her grandchildren and spoiling her great- grandchildren too. She was an excellent cook and always made sure everyone else around her

had eaten and was taken care of, often from her own garden, fresh cooking and canning. She loved to sew and was quite the seamstress for many.

Above all, she enjoyed being with her family. She also enjoyed listening to gospel music, attending church, watching Christian based movies, with a few crime shows from time to time. Opinionated and strong-willed, she left little doubt of what she thought and how things needed to be done. She was not shy about sharing her faith and was concerned about the salvation of others. She was a great friend, had a servant's heart, always lending a hand, and willing to help anyone in need. With diligent hands, dedicated heart, and desired holiness, Evelyn, or known by most as "nana" will be greatly missed.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Parks and Lucille (McCart) Kilgore, and four brothers: baby JD, Gerald, Claude, and Cecil.
