



## Everett "Mac" McAlister

May 20, 1932 - March 1, 2009

Everett S. (Mac) McAlister of Loganville, GA, and formerly of Titusville, FL, went home to his eternal reward on Sunday, March 1, 2009. He was preceded in death by son: Kevin McAlister in 1974 and is survived by his wife of 55 years, Patricia A. McAlister; daughters: Cindy Bowers and husband Phil of Lilburn, Linda Cheek and husband Chris of Lawrenceville; granddaughters: Ashley Wood of Lawrenceville, Kate Bowers of Abilene, TX, and Amanda Bowers of Lilburn; sister Harriet Perrett of Pittsburgh, PA; and numerous nieces, nephews and cherished friends.

Mac was born in Pittsburgh, PA on May 20, 1932. A veteran of the U.S. Air Force during the Korean War, he received a degree in electrical engineering from the University of Pittsburgh in 1960. He began his career in the aerospace industry in 1960 with Boeing Aerospace and retired in 1996 after a career spent primarily at the Kennedy Space Center in Cape Canaveral, FL, where he was actively involved in the Mercury, Gemini, Apollo and Space Shuttle programs.

During their years in Florida, the McAlisters were active members of the Mims United Methodist Church where Mac was active in a number of ministries, including the choir, Sunday school teacher, and men's ministry. He played a leading role in many church fund-raising activities, often entertaining with his unique blend of humor and music.

Mac was also a volunteer fireman for Mims, FL and a volunteer baseball coach for Titusville Astronaut High School. An avid golfer and tennis player, he

injoyed life while remaining involved with his church and his family. Mac's love of people, and his self-deprecating sense of humor endeared him to all who knew him.

Upon retirement, the McAlisters moved to Loganville to be nearer to their daughters and granddaughters. They were active members of the Walnut Grove United Methodist Church, where Mac served in a number of capacities, including lay leader and choir member.

A Celebration of Life service will be held at the Walnut Grove United Methodist Church on Saturday, March 7 at 11:00AM with Rev. Jamie Hudgins officiating. The family will receive visitors on Friday evening, March 6 from 6:00 to 8:00PM at the Tim Stewart Loganville Chapel.
