



Flora Myrtle Lipham Rolader

June 10, 1920 - February 2, 2025

Flora Myrtle Lipham Rolader, affectionately known by most as Mom R, was born on June 10, 1920, and went to her heavenly home with her beloved Savior, Jesus, on February 2, 2025. At the incredible age of 104, she passed peaceably in her sleep, leaving a strong legacy of faith to her family and friends.

In her 104 years of life, Mom R lived through the Great Depression, World War II, and had many ups and downs. She had a faith that sustained her, and she exhibited a joyful and enthusiastic approach to life. She had a can-do attitude that enabled her to succeed in all aspects of life. Though times were tough, she excelled academically as salutatorian of her class when she graduated high school, and she obtained a business degree. She was employed much of her life as an accountant.

She met her husband, Ezra Rolader, when he was on leave from the Army, where he served heroically as a paratrooper and was behind enemy lines in the war. Together they raised five children and settled in the Atlanta area.

Her greatest hobby was bowling, which she did until age 99, and she was good at it! She was a charter member of the Atlanta Women's Bowling Association and enjoyed many bowling leagues, fellow bowlers, and tournaments.

Without a doubt, her greatest life passion was loving and serving her Lord Jesus Christ! She was an active member of Peachtree Baptist Church in Atlanta and Rehoboth Baptist Church in Tucker, where at both churches she sang in the choir and taught an adult women's Sunday School class until age 95. She cherished the Bible and its teachings which informed every aspect of her life and molded her into the beloved person she was.

Mom R is preceded in death by her parents, Ava and Herbert Lipham; her husband, Ezra Thomas Rolader; and by two of her children, Gail Dempsey and Tom Rolader. She is survived by three of her children and their spouses, Flo and Spruce Newman, Joyce and Bevan McWhirter, and Jim and Lisa Rolader; her son-in-law, Doug Dempsey; 11 grandchildren; 25 great grandchildren; and 4 great-great grandchildren.
