Frank T Rogers, age 86, of Loganville, passed away Wednesday, May 27, 2026.

He was born on December 28, 1939, in Habersham County, Georgia, to Roy and Helen (Greene) Rogers and attended Eastanollee High School in Stephens County. He later enlisted in the United States Air Force, where he served his country with honor and distinction. After his military service, he worked for Delta Airlines as a jet engine mechanic before pivoting to a new career path as a master plumber.

Frank was deeply devoted to his family and took great joy in supporting his children and grandchildren in all their sports and arts activities. He also gave generously of his time as a youth baseball coach. He also served as Vice President of the Loganville High School Dugout Club from 2001 to 2002, reflecting his deep commitment to his community and to the young people he encouraged. Frank loved Georgia sports and could always be counted on to cheer for his favorite teams, from the Braves to the Bulldogs.

Frank was an avid deer hunter and was known for his good luck in the woods—so much so that everyone loved hunting from his deer stand, which came to be known as “Granddaddy’s stand.” When he was not outdoors, you could often find him happily “piddling” around the house or lending a hand with

someone else's home improvement project.

Of all his accomplishments, Frank was most proud of his children and the strong work ethic he instilled in them. His love, guidance, and steady example will be remembered by all who knew him.

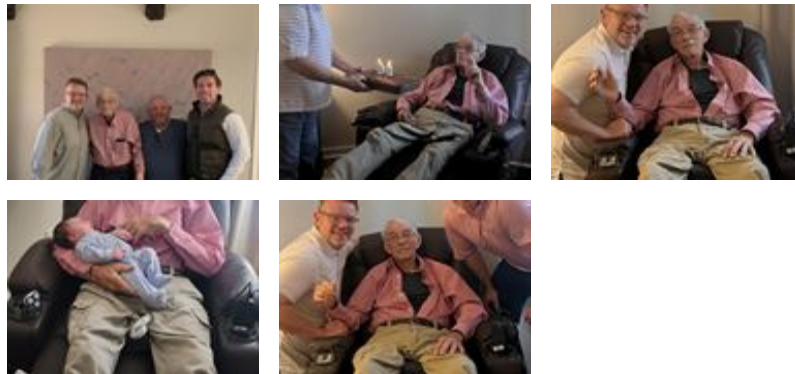
