CMSgt Frederick "Fred" Rider, USAF Ret., age 72 of Loganville, passed away on Friday, July 5, 2019. A Memorial Service will be held at 1:30 PM on Thursday, July 11, 2019 at Holy Cross Cathedral. Inurnment will take place at 9:00 AM on Friday, July 12, 2019 at Georgia National Cemetery in Canton, GA. Fred retired from the United States Air Force after 20 years of service. He served during Vietnam and was a recipient of the Distinguished Flying Cross and numerous other medals. Fred was also a member of the Holy Cross Anglican Cathedral in Loganville.
