Mr. Frederick Joseph Walker, affectionally known as “Freddie” or “Joe” was born October 29, 1979, in Albany, GA, to the late Fred and Mary Emma Walker. At an early age, Joe developed a love for sports, football in particular. In elementary school, Joe played football with the City of Albany Parks and Recreation Department, and he continued showcasing his talents on the field when he entered high school, where he joined Golden Tornadoes football team.

Joe received his high school diploma from Monroe Comprehensive High School, in Albany, GA, in 1998, and after graduation from high school, he attempted to enlist in the military, but it was discovered that he suffered from end-stage renal disease, which prevented him from serving his country. Though this diagnosis was a setback for Joe, it was through end-stage renal disease that he later met and married Wanetta Frankin in 2017, who preceded him death five years later.

At a young age, Joe was baptized in faith, and he maintained a close spiritual relationship with the Lord throughout his life. Professionally, Joe worked at a Publix Distribution Center, taking great pride in his work.

On Saturday, November 9, 2024, God whispered into Joe’s ear and told him that it was time for him to come home to walk alongside Him and the other angels in heaven.

Joe leaves behind his two sons: Elijah Joseph Walker of Atlanta, GA, and Aaron James Walker of Ashburn, GA; sisters: Deidra Antonia Ferguson (Kenny) of St. Petersburg, FL, and Emma Leigh Walker of Albany, GA; one niece: Erika Walker of St. Petersburg, FL; one great-niece: Dejanee Walker of St. Petersburg, FL; one great-great niece: Cayleah Walker of St. Petersburg, FL; a special friend: Caldine "Callie" Brown of Atlanta, GA; a sister-cousin: Delothia Anthony of Austell, GA; a host of family and friends.

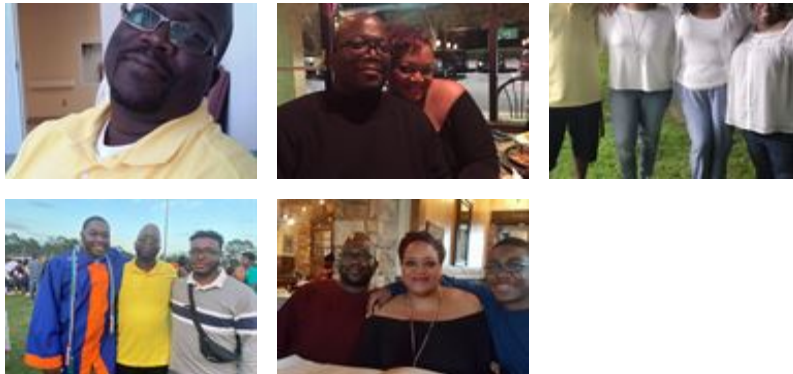
