William Gary Hornsby, beloved husband, devoted father, doting grandfather, and cherished friend, passed away peacefully on February 16, 2024, surrounded by his loving family. He was 73 years old. He is survived by his wife of 54 years Sally; children Kindra, Justin (Stacey), and Tory (Cristy); 12 grandchildren: Tyler (Victoria), Taylor (Landon), Bailey, Sydney, TJ, Emma, Chandler, Will, Miriam, Lydia, Ruthie, and Callie; sisters Elaine Davis (Jerry), Debbie Thomas, and Susan Hyde (Mike); siblings-in-law: Linda Parker, Patricia Haliburton, Faye Leonard, Johnny Cunard and Doug Cunard (Jennifer). Gary was a beacon of light to all who knew him, radiating kindness and selflessness. He was a constant source of support and encouragement and

was always willing to lend a helping hand. Known for his quick wit and infectious laughter, his repertoire of dad jokes was legendary and has been carried on by his children.

A Celebration of Life service will be held on Monday 2/26 at 11am at Rockdale Community Church in Conyers, GA. The family will receive guests for Visitation on Sunday 2/25, 3-5pm at Rockdale Community Church, as well as prior to the service on Monday 2/26 from 9:45-10:45am.
