Gary Franklin Morgan, age 72, passed away on Saturday, November 20, 2021, following complications from prostate cancer and a stroke.

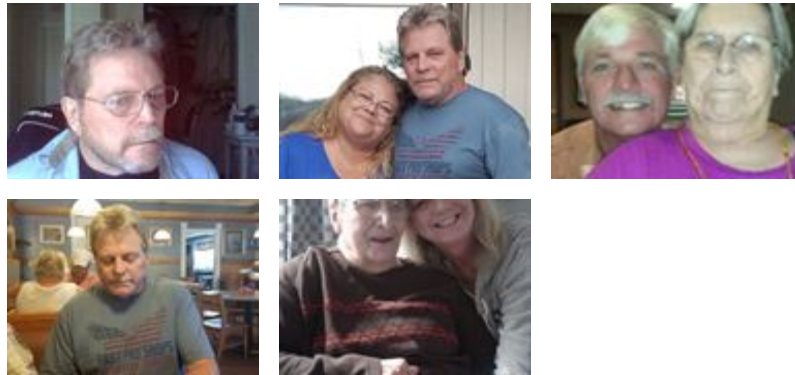
