Gary Paul Schuster of Dacula, GA, passed away on November 1, 2021, at the age of 78, after a brief illness. He was born in Mobile, Alabama on October 3, 1943. Gary is survived by his loving wife Elaine of almost 50 years of marriage. He is also survived by his daughter Christine Schuster Sanchez of Marietta, GA and son in law Chris Sanchez; and a niece and several nephews. Gary was the son of the late Paul and Pauline Schuster of Mechanicsburg, PA. In 1998, he was predeceased by his son, Brian Schuster. Gary grew up in Scotia, NY and graduated from Scotia-Glenville H.S. He served in the U.S. Navy aboard the USS Dyess and is a veteran of Vietnam. After his military service, Gary obtained a Bachelor of Science degree from McPherson College where he was a member of the varsity baseball and football teams. He continued his education at Kansas State University and received a Master's degree in Political Science and later earned a MBA from Central Michigan University.

In 2012, after being employed for 39 years, Gary retired from the agricultural equipment industry. During his career, he traveled extensively throughout the United States and Canada and held various managerial positions in sales, marketing, collections, and business management.
