WERNECKE – Gary Wernecke, age 88 of Loganville, GA, passed away on Saturday, April 18, 2026. 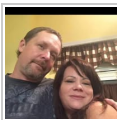

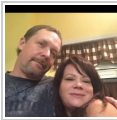
